Case Study: The Benefits of Corporate Breakout Sessions for Employees

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The science is real: working in the same environment has several negative effects on employees.



Decreased creativity and productivity: According to a famous study, monotony in the work environment was found to be negatively associated with both creativity and productivity, and communication among the team (Neely, et al., 2013).

Increased stress levels: A review of studies found that prolonged exposure to a monotonous work environment can lead to increased stress levels (Bakker & Demerouti, 2014).

Decreased employee engagement and morale: Another study found that a lack of variety in the work environment was associated with decreased employee engagement and morale (Macey & Schneider, 2008).

Decreased physical and mental well-being: It's also bene found that prolonged exposure to a sedentary work environment was associated with decreased physical and mental well-being (Shook & Parent, 2016).

It's important to consider these potential negative effects when evaluating the work environment and to take steps to mitigate them. Solutions include providing opportunities for employee breaks, continuous work from home, and having breakout sessions in different locations.



The benefits of off-site breakout sessions are tremendous for employees.

Boosts Overall Job Satisfaction Employees who feel valued and supported by their leaders are more satisfied with their job overall (Shook & Parent, 2016).
